Why a new literacy program?

This is a state mandate. Our district is required to implement a program for grades K-3 that has been approved by the Connecticut State Department of Education.

What the state approved programs have that our current curriculum still needs:

- Systematic and cumulative instruction of vocabulary, language skills, and reading comprehension
- An assessment and remediation system for all of the tiers and special education
- Systematic building of content knowledge

The research and selection process

- 1) The companies that publish the state approved programs were contacted, followed by extensive conversations with program representatives.
- 2) Samples of all programs were reviewed utilizing the state evaluation tool, as well as a district needs checklist.
- 3) Feedback was solicited from teachers, coaches, and administrators of other districts that are currently implementing the state approved programs.
- **4)** Feedback was solicited from WPS staff (CES and HMS).


Cumulative Instruction- CKLA skills and knowledge build from lesson to lesson, unit to unit, and grade to grade.


